Faculty Member (part-time position)

Roles and Responsibilities:

Teaching:

- → teach a minimum of 6 courses each semester (course preparations minimized)
- → The total number of teaching hours is 360 hours per academic year
- → responsible for class preparation, student feedback, and student experience

Collaboration:

 \rightarrow Work alongside the Director of Academics, Director of Faculty, Department Chairs, and Director of Learning Strategy and Operations to provide a robust and student-centered learning experience.

Support:

- → Develop expertise in a variety of technology platforms including Canvas, Veracross, and other content-specific platforms (MyLab, Pivot, Voces, etc.)
- → Create and implement a variety of support strategies/plans to help teachers and students



Time Commitment

This is a part-time remote position. We ask all Prestans faculty to provide guaranteed availability during **two** of the following time frames **5 days a week:**

Course preparations will be minimized and the total number of students will be 30-35 enrolled in your 6 classes.

Compensation

Faculty members at Prestans will be compensated \$32,500.00 a year for their 360 hours of instruction. This includes class preparation, grading, student feedback, etc.
